3. Unruly pets may be sent home or disqualified by the judge.
4. **All dogs and cats over 3 months of age must have been vaccinated recently, and proof of current vaccination must be presented.**
5. Pets do not have to be a registered pet to be entered in this show.
6. Awards will be given according to decision of the judge. All decisions are final.
7. The Pet Show is open to any resident of Cumberland County.
8. Cash prizes will be awarded: Adult: 1st Place, \$3.00, 2nd Place, \$2.00, 3rd Place, \$1.00, Adult Best of Show, \$5.00. Youth: 1st Place, \$3.00, 2nd Place, \$2.00, 3rd Place, \$1.00, Youth Best of Show, \$5.00. Adults and Youth will be showing simultaneously.
