RULES

Livestock Show can be picked up at the UT Extension Office.

ELIGIBILITY

Competition is limited to Cumberland County youth who are enrolled in 4-H; or are FFA members who were enrolled in vocational agriculture on August 1 of the current calendar year and who have not reached the end of the calendar year of their 20th birthday; or youth who will be enrolled in the third grade as of August 1, and who are participants in an educational livestock project group. The exhibitors must be under the supervision of an Extension agent or a teacher of vocational agriculture.

DATES FOR OWNERSHIP AND/OR REGISTRATION

Animals must be individually owned in the name of the exhibitor and be in the possession and care of the exhibitor by June 1 and shall remain in possession of the exhibitor until after the shows completion. All animals to be shown and sold must be registered through the UT Extension Office

ENTRIES

1. Youth may enter and exhibit up to 2 steers / heifers, 3 lambs, 2 hogs, and / or 3 goats. Youth may sell 1 steer, 1 hog, 2 goats and 2 lambs.
2. All animals must be pre-registered with the UT Extension with all entries being received by June 1st. All animals entered must be tagged and / or tattooed to be identified and must be verified by either an Extension Agent and / or Vocational Ag Teacher.
3. Entries are to be made on entry forms that can be obtained from the local Agricultural Extension Service Office.
4. All entries must be submitted through the local UT Extension Service office.
5. This is the procedure for entries by both 4-H and FFA members.
6. Entry fees of \$3.00 per head for beef animals and \$1.00 per head for goat/sheep/swine are due upon registration of animals.
7. A 5% commission will be charged on all animals sold.
8. All youth entries must agree to the use of photographs, etc as publicity for promotion of the Jr. Livestock program and its sponsors.

SHOW

1. Classes will be determined by weight.
2. Showmanship classes for each specie will precede the market animal show. Showmanship classes will be divided as follows Senior (ages 16-20), Junior High (ages 12-15), and Junior (ages 8-11). There will also be a special novice showmanship class for any exhibitor 7 years of age and younger.

SALE

1. All livestock must meet minimum sale weight requirements to be sold. Sale weights are as follows....steers and heifers 1000 pounds, hogs 230 pounds, lambs 90 pounds, and goats 75 pounds. Animals not meeting these guidelines will be permitted to show but will not be permitted to sale.
2. The purpose of this live auction is to provide an opportunity for young boys and girls to sell their market animals. This is a premium sale and should be viewed as a support auction for this youth program. Thus, the animal will remain in the ownership and possession of the exhibitor until a point in time at which the animals reaches a terminal endpoint show. Such terminal endpoint show must fall within 90 days of the Cumberland County Fair Youth Market Livestock Show and Sale. Once the animal has been exhibited at its final show, the purchaser will gain ownership of the animal. The exhibitor will be responsible for delivery of the animal to the desired location of the processor.
3. All animals must be declared 1 hour prior to the sale to the Extension Agent for entry in the sale.
4. Exhibitors/owners must be present to sell. No substitution of handlers.
5. A 5% commission will be charged on all animals to be sold. All proceeds go directly to support the Jr. Livestock program.
6. Any unethical practices will not be tolerated.
